Iowa Code § 96.3(7) – Recovery of Benefit Overpayment

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant filed an appeal from the December 28, 2017, (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision that concluded she was overpaid benefits. The claimant was properly notified about the hearing. An in-person hearing was held in Des Moines, Iowa, on January 23, 2018. The claimant participated personally. Claude Williams, former co-worker, also participated on behalf of the claimant. Claimant Exhibits A through D were received into evidence. The administrative law judge took official notice of the administrative records including the fact-finding documents. Based on the evidence, the arguments presented, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

ISSUE:

Has the claimant been overpaid any unemployment insurance benefits?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The claimant filed a new claim for unemployment insurance benefits with an effective date of November 26, 2017. The claimant filed for and received a total of \$582.00 in unemployment insurance benefits for the weeks between November 26, 2017 and December 16, 2017.

The unemployment insurance decision that disqualified the claimant from receiving unemployment insurance benefits has been affirmed in a decision of the administrative law judge in appeal 18A-UI-00049-JC.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The issue in this case is whether the claimant was overpaid unemployment insurance benefits.

Iowa Code § 96.3(7) provides, in pertinent part:

7. Recovery of overpayment of benefits.

a. If an individual receives benefits for which the individual is subsequently determined to be ineligible, even though the individual acts in good faith and is not otherwise at fault, the benefits shall be recovered. The department in its discretion may recover the overpayment of benefits either by having a sum equal to the overpayment deducted from any future benefits payable to the individual or by having the individual pay to the department a sum equal to the overpayment.

Since the decision disqualifying the claimant has been affirmed, the claimant was overpaid \$582.00 in unemployment insurance benefits.

DECISION:

The	unemployment	insurance	decision	dated	December	28,	2017,	(reference	02),	is	affirmed.
