# STATEMENT OF THE CASE

On June 18, 2015, Iowa Workforce Development (Department) issued a decision finding Kenton Kollbaum had been overpaid on his unemployment insurance claim. Kollbaum appealed.

The case was transmitted from Iowa Workforce Development to the Department of Inspections and Appeals on June 29, 2015 to schedule a contested case hearing. A Notice of Telephone Hearing was mailed to all parties on July 2, 2015. On July 2, 2015, Kollbaum filed a written withdrawal of the appeal. The Department's rules allow an appellant to
