STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Claimant filed an appeal from a decision of a representative dated June 19, 2007, reference 01, which held claimant not able and available for work. After due notice, a telephone conference hearing was scheduled for and held on July 10, 2007. Claimant participated personally. Employer participated by Lisa Franzmeier, Staffing Consultant. Exhibit A was admitted into evidence.

ISSUE:

The issue in this matter is whether claimant is able and available for work.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having heard the testimony and having considered all of the evidence in the record, finds: Claimant was laid off without work for one week of May 20, 2007. Claimant was fully able and available for work.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Iowa Code section 96.4-3 provides:

An unemployed individual shall be eligible to receive benefits with respect to any week only if the department finds that:

3. The individual is able to work, is available for work, and is earnestly and actively seeking work. This subsection is waived if the individual is deemed partially unemployed, while employed at the individual's regular job, as defined in section 96.19, subsection 38, paragraph "b", unnumbered paragraph 1, or temporarily unemployed as defined in section 96.19, subsection 38, paragraph "c". The work search requirements of this subsection and the disqualification requirement for failure to apply for, or to accept suitable work of section 96.5, subsection 3 are waived if the individual is not disqualified for benefits under section 96.5, subsection 1, paragraph "h".

Benefits shall be allowed effective May 20, 2007, as claimant was able and available for work. Claimant was on layoff.

DECISION:

The decision of the representative dated June 19 2007, reference 01, is reversed. Claimant is eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits, effective May 20, 2007, provided claimant meets all other eligibility requirements.
