STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated November 30, 2006, reference 01, which denied benefits to him for the week ending November 4, 2006. Due notice was issued for a telephone hearing to be held December 18, 2006. At the time of the hearing, the claimant requested that the appeal be withdrawn.

ISSUE:

Should the claimant's request to withdraw his appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having examined all matters of record, the administrative law judge finds: The claimant, the appellant in this matter, has requested that the appeal be withdrawn.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

A rule found at 871 IAC 26.8(1) allows the administrative law judge to grant an appellant's request for the withdrawal of its appeal. A review of all matters of record persuades the administrative law judge that it is appropriate to allow the withdrawal of this appeal.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated November 30, 2006, reference 01, remains in effect. The claimant is ineligible for unemployment insurance benefits for the week ending November 4, 2006.
