STATEMENT OF THE CASE

The claimant filed an appeal of a representative's decision dated February 3, 2010, reference 01. A Notice of Telephone Hearing was mailed to all parties on March 19, 2010 setting a hearing date of April 12, 2010 at 1:00 PM. The notice contained instructions regarding how to participate in the telephone hearing. The claimant did not call in to participate in the hearing at the date and time indicated.

The Iowa Administrative Procedure Act provides that if a party fails to appear or participate in a contested case proceeding after proper service of notice, the presiding

officer may enter a default decision.¹ Iowa Workforce Development regulations give the presiding officer discretion regarding whether to proceed with a hearing in the absence of one or more of the parties.² In this case, a hearing was not held and a default decision was entered.

DECISION

The claimant's appeal is dismissed. The Department's decision dated February 3, 2010, reference 01, is affirmed. The Department shall take any action necessary to implement this decision.
