STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The issue of timeliness was raised when the employer filed an appeal postmarked April 4, 2011, a couple of months beyond the statutory deadline of January 25, 2011. The reason for the delay was because the employer never received the Notice of Decision that was originally mailed. For this reason, we find good cause has been established for the late appeal, and the board shall consider it to be timely.
