STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

An appeal was filed from a statement of charges for the first quarter of 2018. A hearing was scheduled for September 6, 2018. Prior to the hearing being held, the appellant requested the appeal be withdrawn.

ISSUE:

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having considered the evidence in the record, finds that: A request has been made by the appealing party to withdraw the appeal. The request has been submitted in writing.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit an oral request to withdraw his or her appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1).

Based on the documents in the appeal file and the applicable law, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of an administrative law judge or the manager or chief administrative law judge of the appeals bureau. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is recorded by the presiding officer.

An appeal may be dismissed upon the request of a party or in the agency's discretion when the issue or issues on appeal have been resolved in the appellant's favor.

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The statement of charges for the first quarter of 2018 with regard to this claimant is affirmed. The request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal is approved.
