STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The employer appealed a department decision dated February 16, 2010, reference 01, that held the claimant was not discharged for misconduct on August 16, 2009, and claimant benefits are allowed. A telephone hearing was held on March 31, 2010. The claimant and employer did not participate in the hearing.

ISSUE:

Whether the claimant was discharged for misconduct in connection with employment.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge having considered the evidence in the record, finds: The claimant worked for the employer as a part-time cashier from July 28, 2009 to August 16, 2009. The employer terminated the claimant from employment.

The claimant and employer failed to respond to the hearing notice.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Iowa Code section 96.5-2-a provides:

An individual shall be disqualified for benefits:

- 2. Discharge for misconduct. If the department finds that the individual has been discharged for misconduct in connection with the individual's employment:
- a. The individual shall be disqualified for benefits until the individual has worked in and has been paid wages for insured work equal to ten times the individual's weekly benefit amount, provided the individual is otherwise eligible.

Appeal No. 10A-UI-02659-ST

The administrative law judge concludes that the claimant was not discharged for misconduct in connection with employment August 16, 2009. The employer failed to participate in this hearing and offer evidence of job disqualifying misconduct.

DECISION:
