Dismissal of Appeal without Prejudice – 481 Iowa Administrative Code 10.24

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

Claimant Delbert D. Crawford filed an appeal from a decision issued by Iowa Workforce Development (“IWD”) dated November 29, 2011, reference 01. IWD found Mr. Crawford was not eligible to receive unemployment benefits because he failed to report to reemployment services orientation.

IWD transmitted the case to the Department of Inspections and Appeals to schedule a contested case hearing. A contested case hearing was scheduled for February 2, 2012, before Administrative Law Judge John M. Priester.

After transferring the file, IWD sent an additional decision, dated January 9, 2012, stating that Mr. Crawford was not disqualified from receiving unemployment benefits. Because no issue remains for resolution in this administrative appeal, the appeal is dismissed. 481 IAC 10.24(1). The hearing on February 2, 2012, is canceled.

### **DECISION**

This appeal is dismissed because no issue remains for resolution in this administrative appeal.
