NOTICE

DECISION

UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS ARE DENIED

The Claimant appealed this case to the Employment Appeal Board. The members of the Employment Appeal Board reviewed the entire record. The Appeal Board finds the administrative law judge's decision is correct. With the following modification, the administrative law judge's Findings of Fact and Reasoning and Conclusions of Law are adopted by the Board as its own. The administrative law judge's decision is **AFFIRMED** with the following **MODIFICATION**:

The Employment Appeal Board would modify the administrative law judge's Reasoning and Conclusions of Law to include the following as supportive legal analysis:

The Claimant only worked part-time employment. She was not able and available for the two week period beginning December 27, 2015 through January 8, 2016 when the Employer offered her a couple of jobs for which the Claimant did not respond as established in the administrative law judge's decision.

In addition, the Board would REMAND this matter to the Iowa Workforce Development, Claims Bureau, for a determination of whether the Claimant quit for better employment.
