STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant, Ryan Nelson, filed an appeal from a decision dated June 3, 2010, reference 05. The decision found he was ineligible for extended unemployment benefits on his Iowa claim as he was eligible on a claim in Texas. After due notice was issued, a hearing was held by telephone conference call on July 30, 2010. The claimant participated on his own behalf.

ISSUE:

The issue is whether the claimant is eligible for benefits in Texas.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Ryan Nelson filed a claim for unemployment benefits with an effective date of December 28, 2008. He filed for emergency unemployment compensation benefits June 14, 2009. It was subsequently determined he was eligible for benefits on a combined wage claim in Texas.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The claimant was eligible for unemployment benefits in Texas effective June 14, 2009, based on combined wage credits from that state and from Iowa. He is therefore ineligible for emergency unemployment compensation benefits under his Iowa claim under the provisions of PL 110-252, Title IV.

DECISION:

The representative's decision of June 3, 2010, reference 05, is affirmed. Ryan Nelson is not eligible for emergency unemployment compensation benefits under his Iowa claim.
