STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant filed an appeal from the September 15, 2021, (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits based upon claimant's voluntary quit. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. A telephone hearing was held on November 16, 2021, and was consolidated with the hearing for appeal 21A-UI-20901-S2-T. Claimant Ehab Elsayy participated and testified. Employer Kalil Ajram and Allea Ajram participated through owner Kalil Ajram. The administrative law judge took official notice of the administrative record.

ISSUE:

Did claimant work for this employer?

FINDINGS OF FACT:


Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds: Employer asserts and the administrative record confirms that claimant never worked for this business entity (account number 000000-000). The correct employer is Kalil Ajram and Allea Ajram. (073932-000). The separation from that employer was addressed in a decision dated September 16, 2021 (reference 02). That decision has been affirmed. See 21A-UI-20901-S2-T.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the representative's decision shall be modified without prejudice to either party because claimant never worked for this business entity.

DECISION:

The September 15, 2021, (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision is modified without prejudice to either party as claimant never worked for this business entity.
