#### STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Claimant Antonio Caldeira filed an appeal from a July 1, 2020 (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. A telephone hearing was scheduled for August 24, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. Prior to the hearing date, the appellant/claimant submitted a written request to withdraw the appeal.

## ISSUE:

Whether the request to withdraw the appeal should be granted.

## **FINDINGS OF FACT:**

The appealing party requested to withdraw the appeal before the hearing because he had been approved for Pandemic Unemployment Assistance. The request was submitted in writing and sent via e-mail. The Iowa Workforce Development Unemployment Insurance Appeals Bureau received the written withdrawal of appeal on August 19, 2020.

## REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

## **DECISION:**

The appealing party's request to withdraw the appeal of the July 1, 2020 (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
