### STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant filed an appeal from the March 23, 2010, reference 01, decision that held that the claimant was not eligible for unemployment insurance benefits. A telephone hearing was scheduled for May 17, 2010. Prior to the hearing being held, the claimant, by and through her attorney, requested in writing that the appeal be withdrawn.

#### **ISSUE:**

Whether the appellant should be permitted to withdraw her appeal.

# FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having reviewed the record, makes the following findings of fact: On May 17, 2010, the claimant filed a written request to withdraw her appeal filed on April 1, 2010.

#### **REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved

# DECISION:

The request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal is approved. The Agency representative's decision dated March 23, 2010, reference 01, shall stand and remain in full force and effect
