STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

An appeal was filed from the March 28, 2008, reference 01, decision that denied benefits. A hearing was scheduled for July 16, 2009. During the hearing, it was determined that the claimant did not intend to appeal this decision.

ISSUE:

The issue is whether the appeal was filed in a timely manner.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having heard the testimony and having considered all of the evidence in the record, finds that: The appeal was based upon information the claimant received from a Iowa Workforce Development worker. The claimant intended to appeal a verbal denial of extended benefits.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the appeal should be dismissed.

The issue of whether the claimant is eligible to receive extended benefits is remanded for determination. A copy of that decision shall be mailed to the claimant's last known address.

DECISION:
