## STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

An appeal was filed from the March 28, 2008, reference 01, decision that denied benefits. A hearing was scheduled for July 16, 2009. During the hearing, it was determined that the claimant did not intend to appeal this decision.

#### ISSUE:

The issue is whether the appeal was filed in a timely manner.

### FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having heard the testimony and having considered all of the evidence in the record, finds that: The appeal was based upon information the claimant received from a lowa Workforce Development worker. The claimant intended to appeal a verbal denial of extended benefits.

#### **REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the appeal should be dismissed.
