STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The issue of timeliness was raised when the Claimant filed an appeal that was date-stamped June 30, 2014, 3 days beyond the statutory deadline of June 27, 2014. The reason for the delay was because the Claimant had already hand-delivered the appeal to the Iowa Workforce Development Center on June 23, 2014, but it was timely submitted to the Board.
