### DECISION

## DISSENTING OPINION OF MONIQUE F. KUESTER:

I respectfully dissent from the majority decision of the Employment Appeal Board; I would reverse the decision of the administrative law judge. I would find that the claimant's situation, although unfortunate, cannot be attributable to the employer. Based on her testimony, it is clear that the claimant may continue to suffer from psychological issues. However, I disagree that her inability to work her scheduled time can be categorized as a quit with good cause attributable to the employer. Benefits should be denied.
