STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Iowa Workforce Development (“IWD”) issued a decision finding Appellant was not eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits because IWD mailed him a notice to report and he failed to report. Appellant appealed.

An appeal hearing was scheduled for January 11, 2012. IWD's rules allow an appellant to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision, with the approval of the administrative law judge.¹ The request to withdraw the appeal is granted.

DECISION

Appellant's request to withdraw the appeal is granted. This matter is deemed withdrawn.
