Section 96.5(3)a – Refusal of Work

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

M.J.'s Enterprises, Inc. received a representative's decision dated March 16, 2006, reference 02, which held that no disqualification would be imposed regarding Elaine Fuoss' February 23, 2006 refusal of work. The employer filed notice on March 20, 2006 that Ms. Fuoss was unknown to the business. Due notice was issued scheduling the matter for a telephone hearing to be held on April 29, 2006. Ms. Fuoss indicated at that time that the correct employing unit was M.J.'s Phillips 66.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds: The representative's decision that is the subject of this appeal was mailed to the incorrect employer. M.J.'s Enterprises, Inc. has had no employment relationship with Ms. Fuoss and she has not sought work with the company.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Iowa Workforce Development notified an incorrect employer in this matter. Therefore, the case must be remanded so that notice is given to the correct employer. The correct employer is M.J.'s Phillips 66, a gas station at 1801 South Main Street in Sioux Center, Iowa.

DECISION:

The representative's decision dated March 16, 2006, reference 02, is affirmed at this time. The matter is remanded to Claims so that notice can be given to the correct employer as identified herein.
