STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Samuel J. Cole filed an appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated September 30, 2011, reference 04, that ruled he had been overpaid emergency unemployment compensation benefits totaling \$1,413.74 for the eight weeks ending August 13, 2011. After due notice was issued, a telephone hearing was held February 23, 2012 on a consolidated record with 12A-EUCU-00039-AT.

ISSUE:

Has the claimant filed a timely appeal?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Samuel J. Cole received the fact-finding decision dated September 30, 2011 that ruled he had been overpaid \$1,413.74 for the eight weeks ending August 13, 2011. He did not file an appeal until late December because he was then employed.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

For the reasons stated in the companion decision, the administrative law judge concludes that he lacks jurisdiction to rule on the merits of this case.
