DISSENTING OPINION OF KIM D. SCHMETT:

I respectfully dissent from the majority decision of the Employment Appeal Board; I would reverse the administrative law judge's decision. I would find that the Claimant missed the last two days for personal reasons: (1) she took February 29th off because she thought her job was posted on Craigslist; (2) she was late on March 1, 2016. I would conclude that these absences were unexcused, and that the Employer satisfied their burden of proving disqualifying misconduct. Benefits should be denied until such time she has worked in and has been paid wages for insured work equal to ten times her weekly benefit amount, provided she is otherwise eligible. See, Iowa Code section 96.5(2)"a".
