STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Express Services, Inc. filed a timely appeal from the April 29, 2014, reference 01, decision that allowed benefits. A hearing was scheduled for May 27, 2014. Prior to the hearing being held, the appellant requested that the appeal be withdrawn. Claimant participated. The employer participated by Ms. Jodi Karleski. The appellant requested the appeal to be withdrawn on the record.

ISSUE:

At issue in this matter is whether the appellant herein should be allowed to withdraw its appeal filed May 7, 2014.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge having considered all of the evidence in the record, finds: That a request has been made by the appealing party to withdraw the appeal. The request has been submitted on the record.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The Agency representative's decision dated April 29, 2014, reference 01, is affirmed. The request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal is approved and the decision of the representative shall stand and remain in effect.
