STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

An appeal was filed from an unemployment insurance decision dated October 26, 2020, reference 03. Prior to the hearing being scheduled, the appellant requested the appeal be withdrawn.

ISSUE:

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge finds that: The appealing party submitted a request in writing to withdraw the appeal.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

After reviewing the records and files herein, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal of the unemployment insurance decision dated October 26, 2020, reference 03, is approved, and that decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
