**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

Claimant filed an appeal from the March 23, 2021 (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision that warned claimant to make an active work search. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. A telephone hearing was held on May 15, 2021, at 8:30 a.m. Claimant participated. Appellant withdrew his appeal on the record.

**ISSUE:**

Whether the request to withdraw the appeal should be granted.

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

The appellant requested to withdraw the appeal on the record during the hearing on May 15, 2021.

**REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). An oral request must be tape-recorded by the presiding officer. *Id.*

Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

**DECISION:**

The appealing party's request to withdraw the appeal of the March 23, 2021 (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
