## DECISION

## **UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS ARE DENIED**

Iowa Department of Inspections, Appeals, and Licensing ("DIAL") Hearing Division mailed the administrative law judge's ("ALJ") decision on July 11, 2023. The Claimant had a subsequent hearing with another ALJ on July 28, and testified under oath that they had not received the prior ALJ's decision.
