The Employment Appeal Board would modify the administrative law judge's Findings of Fact to reflect that the claimant did leave a phone message on her supervisor's (Ms. Neimeyer) cell phone on Saturday, June 12, 2010 thanking her for providing the replacement for her that day. (Tr. 20) The supervisor left a cell phone message on the claimant's cell phone notifying her that a replacement had been found for her on Sunday as well as Saturday. (Tr. 30)
