STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Belinda Young filed an appeal from a decision issued by Iowa Workforce Development (the Department) dated February 19, 2015 (reference 01). In this decision, the Department determined that Young was overpaid unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$540 between December 15, 2013 and January 4, 2014.

The case was transmitted from Workforce Development to the Department of Inspections and Appeals on March 12, 2015 to schedule a contested case hearing. A Notice of Telephone Hearing was mailed to all parties on March 16, 2015 scheduling a hearing for April 15, 2015 before Administrative Law Judge Laura Lockard. Prior to the hearing date, the Department issued a decision reducing the overpayment to \$0 based on the review of additional information.

The Department's decision dated March 19, 2015 reducing the Appellant's overpayment to \$0 has made the Appellant's case moot as this is the relief she sought through the appeal process.

DECISION

The Appellant's appeal is dismissed as moot. The Department has amended its decision to eliminate the overpayment that the Appellant challenged. The Department shall take any action necessary to implement this decision.

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
