**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

Joshua Mohr filed an appeal from the April 9, 2015 (reference 01) decision that disqualified him for benefits and that relieved the employer of liability for benefits, based on an Agency conclusion that he had been discharged on March 29, 2015 for misconduct in connection with the employment. A hearing was scheduled for May 21, 2015. Mr. Mohr and employer representative Melissa Schinderle appeared. At the time of the hearing, Mr. Mohr requested to withdraw his appeal.

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

Mr. Mohr is the claimant and appellant in this matter. The appeal hearing was set for May 21, 2015. At the time of the hearing, Mr. Mohr requested to withdraw the appeal. The request was made before a decision had been entered in connection with the appeal.

**REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1) provides:

- (1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the appealing party's request to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

**DECISION:**

The claimant's request to withdraw the appeal is approved. The April 9, 2015 (reference 01) decision that disqualified the claimant for benefits and that relieved the employer of liability for benefits, based on the March 29, 2015 separation, shall remain effect.
