DISSENTING OPINION OF KIM D. SCHMETT:

I respectfully dissent from the majority decision of the Employment Appeal Board; I would reverse the administrative law judge's decision. I would find the Employer provided the Claimant with the opportunity to print out the notification policy that was available online. When she ended her assignment, however, she failed to report to the Employer and request a new assignment in compliance with the notification policy. For this reason, I would conclude the Claimant guit and should be denied benefits until such time she has worked in and was paid wages for insured work equal to ten times her weekly benefit amount, provided she is otherwise eligible. See, Iowa Code section 96.5(1)"g".
