Iowa Code § 96.5 – Unpaid Fraud Overpayment Balance Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1) – Withdrawal of Appeal

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

An appeal was filed by the claimant from the Iowa Workforce Development representative's decision dated September 11, 2020 (reference 02) that found the claimant had an unpaid fraud overpayment balance. A hearing was scheduled for November 6, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. Prior to the hearing being held, the appellant/claimant requested the appeal be withdrawn on the record.

ISSUE:

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having considered the evidence in the record, finds that: A request has been made by the appealing party to withdraw the appeal. The request has been submitted to the Appeals Bureau in writing.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

For the reasons that follow, the administrative law judge concludes the request to withdraw the appeal is granted.

Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of an administrative law judge or the manager or chief administrative law judge of the appeals bureau. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is taperecorded by the presiding officer.

An appeal may be dismissed upon the request of a party or in the agency's discretion when the issue or issues on appeal have been resolved in the appellant's favor.

The appellant/claimant has made a request in writing to withdraw the appeal. The administrative law judge has reviewed the record and concludes that the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The decision of the representative dated September 11, 2020 (reference 02) that found the claimant had an unpaid fraud overpayment balance shall stand and remain in full force and effect. The request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal is approved and the hearing scheduled for November 6, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. is cancelled.
