### STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The employer appealed a representative's October 12, 2010 determination (reference 01) that held the claimant qualified to receive benefits and the employers account subject to charge. A hearing was scheduled on December 13, 2010. Prior to the hearing, the employer's representative made a request to withdraw the employer's appeal. Based on the employer's withdrawal request, the administrative record, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT:

The employer withdrew its appeal from the representative's October 12, 2010 determination. The employer's withdrawal request was faxed to the Appeals Section on December 9, 2010.

## **REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The employer's request to withdraw its appeal is approved.

# **DECISION:**

The representative's October 12, 2010 determination (reference 01) is affirmed. The employer's withdrawal request is approved. The claimant remains qualified to receive unemployment insurance benefits as of August 1, 2010, provided she meets all other eligibility requirements. The employer's account may be charged.
