STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Rosenda M Taylor, the claimant/appellant, filed an appeal from the July 27, 2020 unemployment insurance decision that allowed Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) benefits. Ms. Taylor was properly notified of the hearing. A telephone hearing was held on April 20, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. Ms. Taylor participated and testified. Ms. Taylor withdrew her appeal on the record.

ISSUE:

Should Ms. Taylor's request to withdraw her appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Ms. Taylor requested to withdraw her appeal of the PUA decision on the record during the hearing on April 20, 2021.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). An oral request must be tape-recorded by the presiding officer. *Id.*

Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, Ms. Taylor's request to withdraw her appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

Ms. Taylor's request to withdraw her appeal of the July 27, 2020 unemployment insurance decision is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.

 4. Relevant facts that you feel would justify a waiver.
- If you are not eligible for a waiver, you will have to repay the benefits you received.
