STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

David Hill (claimant) appealed an unemployment insurance decision dated December 22, 2010, reference 02, which held that he was not eligible for unemployment insurance benefits because he was employed at the same hours and wages with Labor World of Iowa (employer). Administrative Law Judge Susan Ackerman conducted an initial hearing on this matter in appeal 11A-UI-00043-BT, in which benefits were denied. The claimant appealed the decision and the Employment Appeal Board remanded for further development of the record in an order dated May 20, 2011. A hearing was scheduled for July 20, 2011. The claimant did not participate in the second scheduled unemployment appeal hearing. Based on the appellant's failure to participate in the hearing, the administrative file, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

ISSUE:

The issue is whether the claimant is working the same hours and wages as in his original contract of hire with this employer.

FINDINGS OF FACT:
