STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Heidi Kieffer filed a timely appeal from the February 5, 2008, reference 01, decision that denied benefits and that concluded she did not meet the work availability requirements of lowa Code section 96.4(3). 871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The Agency representative's February 5, 2008, reference 01, decision is affirmed. The request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal is approved, and the decision of the representative shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
