Section 96.3-5-b – Training Extension Benefits

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Amber L. Rechkemmer filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated July 22, 2011, reference 06, that denied training extension benefits to her effective June 5, 2011, upon a finding that she had not provided requested information. After due notice was issued, a telephone hearing was held August 23, 2011, with Ms. Rechkemmer participating. Exhibit A was admitted into evidence.

ISSUE:

Is the claimant eligible for training extension benefits?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Amber L. Rechkemmer was a student at Upper Iowa University in the spring semester of the 2010-11 academic year. She earned 12 hours of credit with a G.P.A of 2.0008. She has registered for the fall semester and has begun classes. She has now provided a copy of her grades for the spring semester and schedule for the fall semester.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Training extension benefits were denied effective June 5, 2011, because the Agency had not received information from the claimant needed to show that she was making reasonable progress in her classes. The information has now been provided.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated July 22, 2011, reference 06, is reversed. The claimant is entitled to receive training extension benefits, provided she is otherwise eligible.
