STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant filed an appeal from the November 4, 2020, (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits based upon a finding that claimant was between academic years or terms. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. A telephone hearing was held on November 18, 2021, and was consolidated with the hearing for appeals 21A-UI-21132-S2-T, 21A-UI-21134-S2-T, 21A-UI-21135-S2-T, and 21A-UI-21136-S2-T. The claimant Frances J. Hippen participated and testified. The employer Cedar Rapids St. Matthew participated through business manager Bill Klein and was represented by Paul Jahnke. Claimant's Exhibit A was admitted. The administrative law judge took official notice of the administrative record.

ISSUE:

Did claimant work for this employer?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds: Claimant and employer assert and the administrative record confirms that claimant never worked for this business entity (account number 108530-119). The employer account number was entered incorrectly into the claim. The correct employer is Ames – St. Cecilia (account number 108530-112). The issue of whether claimant is eligible between academic years or terms with that employer has not yet been determined by the IWD Benefits Bureau.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the representative's decision shall be modified without prejudice to either party because claimant never worked for this business entity.

DECISION:

The November 4, 2020, (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision is modified without prejudice to either party as claimant never worked for this business entity.

REMAND:

The issue of whether claimant is eligible between academic years or terms as related to the actual employer (account number 108530-112) as delineated in the findings of fact is remanded to the Benefits Bureau of Iowa Workforce Development for an initial investigation and determination.
