STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Laura C Scholl, the claimant/appellant, filed an appeal from the October 16, 2020, (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits. The parties were properly notified about the hearing. A telephone hearing was held on January 11, 2021. Ms. Scholl participated and testified. The employer participated through Deb McCurdy, store manager. Ms. Scholl withdrew her appeal on the record.

ISSUES:

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Ms. Scholl requested to withdraw the appeal on the record during the hearing on January 11, 2021.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). An oral request must be tape-recorded by the presiding officer. *Id.*

Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, Ms. Scholl's request to withdraw her appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

Ms. Scholl's request to withdraw her appeal of the October 16, 2020 (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision is approved. The October 16, 2020 (reference 01) decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
