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Dismissal of Appeal – 481 Iowa Administrative Code 10.24

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

Claimant/Appellant Timothy Lyttle appealed a decision issued by Respondent Iowa Workforce Development dated March 18, 2016, reference 01, finding Lyttle was not eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits effective March 13, 2016 because he was mailed a notice to report for a reemployment and eligibility assessment on March 17, 2016 and he failed to report.

Iowa Workforce Development transmitted the administrative file to the Department of Inspections and Appeals to schedule a contested case hearing. A contested case hearing was scheduled for May 9, 2016. Iowa Workforce Development submitted a new decision dated March 23, 2016, reference 02, finding Lyttle is eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits effective March 13, 2016. Iowa Workforce Development requests the appeal be dismissed. Because no issues remain for resolution in this administrative appeal, the appeal is dismissed.<sup>1</sup>

### **DECISION**

This appeal is dismissed because no issues remain to be resolved.
