Section 96.4—3 Missing Wages

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Claimant filed an appeal from a decision of a representative dated October 20, 2011, reference 01, which held claimant ineligible for unemployment insurance benefits on the basis that “records indicate that no wages were paid to you by” the employer. This appeal was taken in the Davenport office but not received by the Appeals Section until January 27, 2012. After due notice, a telephone conference hearing was scheduled for and held on March 6, 2012. Claimant participated personally. Employer failed to participate.

ISSUE:

The issue in this matter is whether the claimant had wages from this employer in the base period.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having heard the testimony and considered all of the evidence in the record, finds: The claimant earned wages for Interstate Management Company in the amount of \$2,422.00 during the 3rd quarter of 2010. Claimant believes she also worked in the second quarter of 2010, but provided no corresponding documentation.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Pursuant to Iowa Code section 96.3(4) and 96.3(5) (2011), claimant earned wages during her base period. It appears that the Unemployment Division has already corrected this error following a missing wage investigation. The matter is remanded to the Unemployment Division for redetermination of eligibility based upon the additional wages.

DECISION:

The decision of the representative dated October 20, 2011, reference 01, is reversed and remanded for a re-determination of monetary eligibility.
