STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant, Jennifer Simpson, filed an appeal from a decision dated May 29, 2013, reference 01. The decision disqualified her from receiving unemployment benefits. After due notice was issued, a hearing was scheduled to be held by telephone conference call on December 6, 2013.

ISSUE:

The issue is whether the claimant quit work with good cause attributable to the employer.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

A hearing was held in this matter on August 7, 2013, in appeal 13A-UI-06530-HT, and both parties participated. A decision was issued on August 7, 2013, and appealed to the Employment Appeal Board (EAB). The EAB remanded the matter for the limited purpose of taking additional testimony from the claimant Jennifer Simpson.

The current hearing was scheduled for 11:30 a.m., December 6, 2013, but the claimant did not provide a telephone number where she could be contacted. By the time the record was closed at 12:00 p.m. the claimant had not contacted the Appeals Bureau to participate. No additional testimony was offered by the claimant.

The Findings of Fact from Appeal 13A-UI-06530-HT are adopted in this decision as though set out here in full.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The Reasoning and Conclusions of Law from Appeal 13A-UI-06530-HT are adopted in this decision as though set out here in full.

DECISION:

The representative's decision of May 29, 2013, reference 01, is affirmed. Jennifer Simpson is disqualified and benefits are withheld until she has earned ten times her weekly benefit amount in insured work, provided she is otherwise eligible.
