## STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant/appellant, Barry Smith, filed an appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated May 18, 2017, reference 04. Before a hearing was scheduled, the claimant/appellant submitted a written withdrawal of this appeal. The appellant specifically asked to withdraw this appeal.

ISSUE:
Should the appeal withdrawal be approved?

## FINDINGS OF FACT:

An unemployment insurance decision was issued on May 18, 2017, reference 04, denying benefits as of $05 / 14 / 17$ because the claimant failed to report for a reemployment and eligibility assessment on May 17, 2017. The claimant filed an appeal online on May 22, 2017. On May 25, 2017, the claimant requested to withdraw this appeal, in writing, via email. The IWD Appeals Bureau received the written withdrawal on that date.

## REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw his or her appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1).

Based on the documents in the appeal file and the applicable law, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

## DECISION:

The appealing party's request to withdraw the appeal of the unemployment insurance decision dated May 18, 2017, reference 04, is approved.
