# STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Denise Harrison, the claimant/appellant, filed an appeal from the April 2, 2021, (reference 05) unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits as of December 6, 2020. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. A telephone hearing was held on June 16, 2021, at 3:00 p.m. Ms. Harrison participated and testified. The employer participated through Melissa Lewien. Ms. Harrison withdrew her appeal on the record.

# **ISSUE:**

Should Ms. Harrison's request to withdraw her appeal be granted?

# FINDINGS OF FACT:

Ms. Harrison requested to withdraw her appeal on the record during the hearing on June 16, 2021.

#### **REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). An oral request must be tape-recorded by the presiding officer. *Id*.

Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, Ms. Harrison's request to withdraw her appeal should be approved.

#### **DECISION:**

Ms. Harrison's request to withdraw her appeal of the April 2, 2021 (reference 05) unemployment insurance decision is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
