STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

On July 19, 2021, Robert Peterson (claimant/appellant) appealed the decision dated July 8, 2021 (reference 04) that concluded the claimant was overpaid Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (FPUC) in the amount of \$7,200.00 based on a prior decision finding he was ineligible for PEUC.

A telephone hearing was held on November 16, 2021, pursuant to due notice. Claimant participated personally and was represented by Attorney James Peters. The administrative law judge took official notice of the administrative record.

ISSUE:

Was the claimant overpaid Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (FPUC)?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds:

The decision which resulted in the overpayment has now been reversed. See 21A-UI-18396-AD-T.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

For the reasons set forth below, the decision dated July 8, 2021 (reference 04) that concluded the claimant was overpaid Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (FPUC) in the amount of \$7,200.00 based on a prior decision finding he was ineligible for PEUC is REVERSED.

The decision which resulted in the overpayment has now been reversed. See 21A-UI-18396-AD-T. Claimant was therefore not overpaid.

DECISION:

The decision dated July 8, 2021 (reference 04) that concluded the claimant was overpaid Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (FPUC) in the amount of \$7,200.00 based on a prior decision finding he was ineligible for PEUC is REVERSED. Claimant was not overpaid FPUC.
