STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Claimant filed an appeal from a decision of a representative dated July 20, 2016, reference 01, which held claimant ineligible for unemployment insurance benefits. After due notice, a telephone conference hearing was scheduled for and held on August 17, 2016. Claimant participated personally. Employer participated by Sarah Fiedler.

ISSUE:

The issue in this matter is whether the claim was previously adjudicated.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having heard the testimony and considered all of the evidence in the record, finds:

This matter was adjudicated in a decision dated August 17, 2016, and by appeal number 16A-UI-08297-B2T.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-24.28(6) provides:

Voluntary quit requalifications and previously adjudicated voluntary quit issues.

(6) The claimant voluntarily left employment. However, there shall be no disqualification under lowa Code section 96.5(1) if a decision on this same separation has been made on a prior claim by a representative of the department and such decision has become final.

In this matter, the evidence has established that the claim was previously adjudicated by decision of July 18, 2016 reference 01. The bureau is without authority to rehear this matter as a decision was issued on the merits and it is still in full force and authority. The issue cannot be adjudicated a second time.

Appeal No. 16A-UI-08298-B2T

DECISION:

The decision of the representative dated July 20, 2016, reference 01, is affirmed. Unemployment insurance benefits shall be withheld until claimant has worked in and been paid wages for insured work equal to ten times claimant's weekly benefit amount, provided claimant is otherwise eligible.
