STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Appellant Nicole Hadenfeldt filed an appeal of two decisions issued by Iowa Workforce Development dated September 16, 2015 (reference 02) and September 17, 2015 (reference 03). A Notice of Telephone Hearing was mailed to all parties on December 16, 2015 setting a hearing date of January 27, 2016 at 9:30 AM. The notice contained instructions regarding how to participate in the telephone hearing. The claimant did not call in to participate in the hearing at the date and time indicated.

The Iowa Administrative Procedure Act provides that if a party fails to appear or participate in a contested case proceeding after proper service of notice, the presiding officer may enter a default decision.¹ Iowa Workforce Development regulations give the presiding officer discretion regarding whether to proceed with a hearing in the absence of the appealing party.² In this case, a hearing was not held and a default decision was entered.

DECISION

The Appellant's appeal is dismissed. The Department shall take any action necessary to implement this decision.
