Section 96.3-5 - Business Closing

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant, Jodie Lee, filed an appeal from a decision dated February 8, 2005, reference 01. The decision found she had not been laid off due to a business closing. After due notice was issued a hearing was scheduled to be held by telephone conference call on March 7, 2005. Prior to the hearing date it was determined the hearing was not necessary.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having examined all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds: Jodie Lee filed a claim for unemployment benefits with an effective date of July 25, 2004. She reopened her claim effective January 23, 2005.

A decision was issued on February 8, 2005, finding that she had not been laid off due to a business closing, and the claimant filed an appeal. On February 21, 2005, a second decision was issued finding the earlier decision had been issued in error and was declared "null and void."

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The hearing in this case is not necessary as the decision from which the appeal was taken has not been declared null and void.

DECISION:

The representative's decision of February 8, 2005, reference 01, is vacated. The initial decision has been declared null and void.
