STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

This matter was erroneously set up as an appeal from the July 12, 2017 (reference 09) unemployment insurance decision which denied claimant's request to have the claim redetermined as a business closing. The claimant did not intend to appeal the decision.

ISSUE:

Was this matter erroneously set up as claimant appeal from an uncontested decision?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, and all the evidence available in the administrative file, the administrative law judge finds: This matter was erroneously set up as a claimant appeal from an uncontested decision which denied the request to have benefits redetermined as a business closure. The claimant did not intend to file an appeal and does not dispute the decision.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The administrative law judge concludes that this matter was erroneously set up as a claimant appeal from an uncontested decision which denied the request to have benefits redetermined as a business closure. The appeal was set up in error. The representative's decision remains in full force and effect.

DECISION:

The July 12, 2017 (reference 09) decision is affirmed. This matter was erroneously set up as a claimant appeal. The representative's decision remains in full force and effect.
