STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant filed an appeal from a decision of a representative dated March 3, 2009, reference 01, which held the claimant ineligible for unemployment insurance benefits. A new decision was issued by a representative on March 19, 2009, reference 03, amended, which found the claimant eligible and held that the employer's account would not be charged. Both parties were notified by telephone that a hearing was not necessary.

ISSUE:

The issue in this matter is whether the claimant's appeal is moot, as he has received a favorable decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having reviewed the administrative record, finds: The claimant filed of a representative's decision dated March 3, 2009 denying him benefits for voluntarily quitting his job without good cause. A timely appeal was filed. A representative's decision was issued on March 19, 2009 that amended the prior decision and found the claimant eligible and also held the employer's account would not be charged.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

As all issues have been resolved in the claimant's favor and employer will not be charged for this claim, there are no issues to decide on appeal. The matter is dismissed.

DECISION:

The decision of the representative dated March 3, 2009, reference 01, is reversed, as it was modified by the March 19, 2009, reference 03, amended decision. The claimant's appeal is dismissed.
