STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The employer filed an appeal from its quarterly statement of charges on November 15, 2018, in the morning. On November 15, 2018, in the afternoon, before a hearing was scheduled, the employer/appellant submitted a written withdrawal of its appeal. No hearing was scheduled or held.

ISSUE:

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The employer appealed from its quarterly statement of charges via email. Shortly thereafter, the employer, the appealing party, requested to withdraw the appeal, in writing, via email.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw his or her appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1).

Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The appealing party's request to withdraw its appeal of the quarterly statement of charges is approved.
